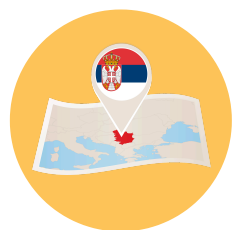

The SPORTISM project (GA n°101090484 - SPORTISM - ERASMUS-SPORT-2022-SCP), co-funded by the European Union under the Erasmus+ Programme aims to promote and strengthen inclusion, social integration and equal opportunities for children and young people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), intellectual and multiple disabilities through sport activities.

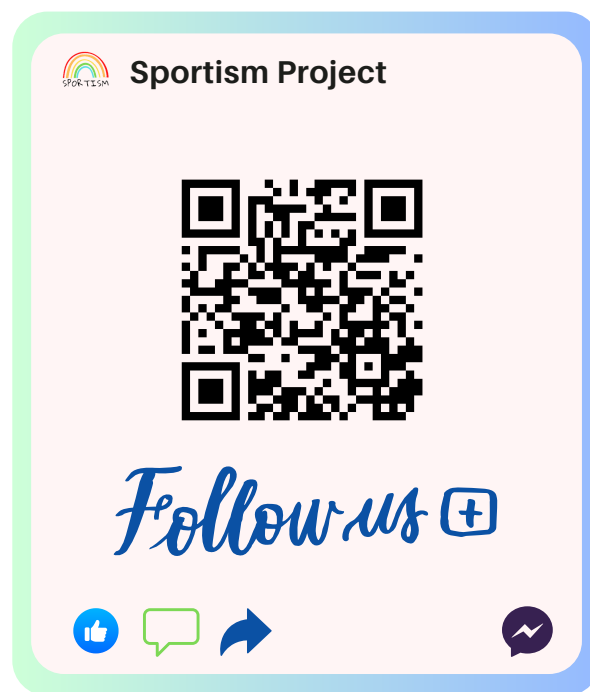
